The 33rd annual Soho Festival will take place in St Anne's Gardens on Sunday 15 July from 12 noon to 6pm. Entry – from Wardour Street – costs just 50p.


This year we are putting the emphasis on live music and entertainment. There will be several live bands including Dick Laurie's Elastic Band, playing New Orleans jazz, and Peter Golding's Blues Band.
